What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week we have been looking at the story of Owl Babies by Martin Waddell. We joined in with the repetitive language in the story and predicted what might happen at the end. We have been collecting twigs and leaves to make nests outside for the owl babies. We have also been singing our Nursery Rhymes daily and learning actions to each song.

In maths this week we have been learning a song called '5 Little Pumpkins in a Vegetable Shop'. We have been practising our counting skills using our counting finger and learning to point to each object as we say the next number. Our number this week was number 2. We used our ten frame to show what 2 looks like as a quantity and searched around our class to find 2 of each object.
