### What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week in Nursery we have been reading the story Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson. We used our story sack to retell the story and looked at how words in the book rhyme at the end of each sentence. We played a game called Silly Soup to help us to hear and identify rhyming words. We used a cauldron and spoon and found words that rhyme to put inside - cat, rat, bat, mat and hat.

In maths this week we have been looking at the **number 3**. We learnt about Thelma Three from Ten Town and all about the number 3. We looked at quantities of 3 and placed them onto a ten frame. We counted out quantities of 3 using pine cones, conkers and pumpkins. We have also been learning about the **triangle**. We counted the number of sides and corners a triangle has and hunted for triangles around our classroom.
