**Mathematics and Literacy**

In Maths this week we have been focussing on the number 1. We developed our awareness of the value of 1. We looked at 1 in terms of money (one pence) and time (1'o'clock).

We have continued to learn some letter sounds (phonemes) this week. We have learnt the letter sounds g, o, c and k. We have also been talking about what makes us good at learning. We read a variety of stories that promote having characteristics such as investigating and exploring, participating, and making choices.
