What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This half term we will be looking at traditional tales. This week we have been looking at the story of Jack and The Beanstalk. We planted our own beans and learnt that the beans will need soil, sunlight and water to help them to grow. We used pictures and props to retell parts of the story and took part in a circle time activity using our imagination to say what we would like to find at the top of the beanstalk.

In maths this week we have been looking at the **number 4**. We looked at quantities of 4 and placed them onto a ten frame. We have been practising counting forwards and backwards and have been ordering numbers that we know. We have been counting the number of sides and corners that squares and rectangles have. We have also been learning about the difference between a square and a rectangle.
