Mathematics and Literacy

In Maths this week we have been learning about one more and one less than a given number. We used number squares and number lines to support this developing knowledge. We also looked at object amounts and took one away and added one to see how this changed the amount altogether. We played a bus stop game, adding one or taking one passenger off the bus.

In Literacy this week we have been making predictions and using our imagination as we have been listening to and retelling stories about dragons. We also recapped adjectives and thought about interesting and exciting ways we could describe the different dragons we encountered in the story.
