What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week we have been looking at jungle animals. We read the book Rumble in The Jungle by Giles Andreae. We tried to spot the rhyming words in each little poem and also looked at the print on each of the animals. In Maths we sorted jungle animals by their print. We looked at which animals had spots, which had stripes and which were plain.

In our phonics this week we have been using our listening skills. We have been listening to jungle animal sounds, making jungle animal sounds and matching sounds to the correct animals. We have also been using our song bag to practise singing our nursery rhymes. Playing our listening games in phonics will help to prepare us for listening for letter sounds when we start to read and write words.
