We learnt the names of baby animals e.g. calf, lamb, fowl and played a game on the interactive Smartboard matching the animals to their babies.

What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week we have been learning about road safety. We read a story called Super Bob by Jude Lennon and talked about the slow down for Bobby campaign and how this story was written to keep us keep safe on the roads. We learnt the rule 1) Stop 2) Look and 3) Listen. We also watched a video to help us understand to always look both ways when crossing the road and to never run into the road even if we drop something like a ball.

In Maths this week, we have been learning about subitising. To subitise means to recognise quantities without counting. We are enjoying learning a song by Jack Hartmann on Youtube to help us. We practised subitising up to 5 using a range of different objects. We have also been using our 5 Hot Cross Buns song to help us subitise and understand that the number changes when you take 1 away.
