Topic Work

This week in Nursery, we read a story called 'A Seed in Need' by Sam Godwin. We have been recapping what seeds need to grow; soil, sunlight and water. We have been watering our seeds that we planted and watching them grow.

We have had fun programming our Code-a-pillar robot this week. We had to arrange his segments to create a sequence to make it move in different directions.

What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week we have started our school phonics program, Read Write Inc. We have learnt letters 'm' and 'a'. In our Read Write Inc. session, we learn about the letter and what sound it makes and look at pictures beginning with each sound. You will be able to access the Read Write Inc Virtual Classroom on our Nursery class web page each week so that you can recap the sounds we have learnt at home.

In Maths this week, we have continued to practise subitising (saying the number without counting) using the different gardening items like seeds, bean, pots and gardening tools. We also used our Ten Town number program and recapped **numbers 0 and 1**. We listened to the story and joined in with the song of Zero Pond and King One. We used the rhymes for Zero Pond (Start at the top, nice and slow. All the way round and there you go.) and King One (From top to toe and there you go.) to help us write the numbers.
