Topic Work

This week is Mental Health Awareness week. In Nursery, we use the Colour Monster story to talk about how we feel each day and use the colours to express each feeling. In Jigsaw, this we have been talking about feeling angry and ways to help us to feel calm again.

We have been doing some painting this week; this is a nice way to help us feel calm. We painted African necklaces using a range of bright colours.

What have we been doing in Nursery this week?

This week in Nursery, we have been looking at the story Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne. We looked closely at the real fruits in the story, talked about how they look, feel and smell on the outside and on the inside. We enjoyed all the delicious fruits for snack including, passion fruit, pineapple and avocado.

In Maths this week, we recapped **number 3**. We listened to the story and song for Ten Town character, Thelma Three. We looked at quantities of 3 and learnt a rhyme to help us write number 3. "over one hand, over the next, stop and think which choice is best". We have been practising counting forwards and backwards from 0-10. We used the story Handa's Hen to help us subitise to 5 (saying the number without counting).
