Please note, in order for children to be registered on time, children in Reception – Year 2 should arrive no later than 8:55am, children in Year 3 – Year 6 should arrive no later than 8:50am.

After this time, children are deemed as being late. The gates are open until 9:00 to allow time for parents to exit the school site.

Children in Reception – Year 2 should be picked up as detailed above at 3:10pm and children from Year 3 – Year 6 should be picked up as detailed above at 3:15pm.

### **A HUGE THANK YOU!**

Thank you so much for sending your children back to school looking so smart in their new school uniform. Please note that if you choose the polo shirt option, it should be embroidered with the school badge rather than a plain polo top, as per the Uniform Policy, which is on our website.

Please ensure that your child's uniform is labelled. You will appreciate that over 400 children all wearing the same uniform can be problematic when trying to locate lost, un-named clothing.

Please note that all pupils should wear black shoes for lesson times. Most children have returned to school wearing these, thank you.

The vast majority of girls have returned wearing lovely bobbles and hairbands in school colours today. Can we remind you that any bobbles or other hair accessories should be discreet and in school colours only. School colours are black, white, grey, green, yellow or red.
