NPSCC NUMBER DAY

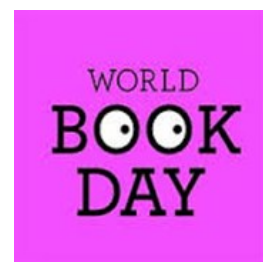
