Dear Parents and Carers,

The city Hubs will close at 4pm on Friday 22nd May.

SMA 'hub' will re-open on Wednesday 3rd June, after Half Term, to **SMA vulnerable children and children of key workers only.** For now, our school 'hub' will continue to operate as it has previously operated during lockdown.

The children who are currently registered with SMA 'hub' can continue to attend.

If you do not have a place currently, and believe that you have a child who is vulnerable, or you are a key worker and might need a place, please email your class teacher (via your class email address) to indicate that you <u>may</u> need a place by **Thursday 21st May at the latest**. If you <u>do not have an email address</u>, then you can call school and leave a message with SMA staff, again, by **Thursday 21st May at the latest**. Key worker families should only use this facility if there is no other adult at home available to look after their child(ren).

Please note, a response asking for a place does not guarantee a place for your child(ren).

SMA 'hub' will open at 9:00am. Registered children should be dropped off, as per current hub procedures, at the main entrance, **from 9:00am but NO LATER than 10:00am** and they can be picked up at any time after lunch (should you wish), but **must be collected no later than 3:15pm.** Please note, school will no longer offer places until 4:00pm.

Should there be an increase in registered vulnerable children attending from 3rd June, it will be necessary to <u>formally stagger</u> start and end of day timings. We will inform you of any changes as soon as possible.

I will update you further, regarding school opening to more pupils once guidance from the Government, Public Health England and the Local Authority is provided.
