



We aim for the children to achieve these goals by the end of Reception.

Communication and Language

To become a confident communicator who listens well and uses their new vocabulary to ask questions, make comments and share ideas. Talk back and forth with friends and adults confidently. To use talk as a way to organise thoughts and connect ideas. To know poems rhymes and songs and confidently talk about books they have heard and read.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

To become resilient and empathetic individuals who can make good friendships, cooperate, persist and show and understanding of the perspective of others. To be resilient and understanding of their self- worth.

Physical Development

To refine and revise fine and gross motor movements. To become proficient and precise when using fine motor control.

<u>Literacy</u>

To become skilled word readers who can decode unfamiliar words and speedily read familiar words. To read and write using their phonic knowledge and with increased accuracy when forming letters. To comprehend the texts they read and hear.

Mathematics

To become competent mathematicians with an ability to count confidently, develop a deep understanding of numbers to 10 and the patterns within those numbers. To compose and decompose shape. To be able to discuss weight, capacity and length.

Understanding the World

To develop the skills to make sense of their environment and community. To recognise the diversity within the world and be able to make links between their knowledge whilst using appropriate vocabulary. To recognise similarities and differences between cultures, environments, religions and beliefs.

Expressive Arts and Design

To become imaginative and creative individuals who are able to express themselves through a variety of media.
