Thank you to everyone who donated on UN Day this week. It was great to see children dressed up to represent the various UN countries. We raised just over £55 for our Courageous Advocacy Fund.

We finish today for our half term holiday and return to school on Monday 6th November.

Upon our return we will have the final week of the after school clubs for the children who attended this half term. The week after, beginning Monday 13th November, children from the waiting lists will be invited to attend the after school clubs they initially showed interest in. These clubs will run for 5 weeks and we will remind you of the end date on the slips sent home. 

ATTENDANCE REPORT

MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER 2023—FRIDAY 27TH OCTOBER 2023



What happens if your child does not attend school regularly?

- You will be contacted by Ms Cavanagh.
- You may be invited to attend a meeting in school to discuss how we can work together to improve your child's attendance and to set up an attendance support plan.
- As a school, we are responsible by law for reporting poor attendance to the local authority.
- As a parent, you are committing an offence if you fail to make sure that your child attends school regularly.
- You run the risk of being issued with a penalty notice or being taken to court.
 A child who has an attendance figure of 90% or below is now classed by the government as 'a child with persistent absence'.

SMA Attendance Target

There is sometimes a perception that an attendance rate of 90% is good.

This is because an examination score of 90% means excellence. However, as an attendance rate, 90% is unsatisfactory, it equates to missing 20 days per year.

We consider below 92% as approaching persistent absence.

The whole school attendance target this year is 97%.

Parent/Carer Support

We must ask you, our Parents/Carers to support us in improving the attendance of our children.

Every lesson really does count for your child, children can quickly fall behind if even one day is missed, catching up even a little lost time from school can be really difficult. Good attendance is linked to achievement, better relationships with other children and better overall behaviour in school.
