In Early Years the children's interests help to form our planning, enhancements and the environment. The children learn through play, direct teaching time, high quality interactions and experiences.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be:

- Continuing to develop their relationships.
- Becoming aware of their own feelings and the feelings of others.
- Increasing independence with personal needs.
- Talking about own needs, wants and interests.
- Learning their own personal limits.

<u>Physical Development</u>

This term we will be:

- Increasingly able to remember sequences and patterns of movement.
- Beginning to: skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.
- Responding to physical challenges.
- Accessing obstacle courses.
- Participating in action songs.
- Drawing circles and lines.

Communication and Language

This term we will be:

- Singing nursery rhymes/songs.
- Developing vocabulary.
- Sequencing stories (not always in order).
- Talking about characters in stories.
- Encouraging and modelling the use of vocabulary heard in stories.
- Responding to questions and instructions directed to them.



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<u>Literacy</u>

This term we will be:

- Learning new vocabulary.
- Looking at books independently and identifying favourite stories.
- Listening and joining in with new and familiar rhymes and stories.
- Creating own stories/retelling stories using puppets/small world.
- Turning pages carefully one at a time.
- Joinina in with repeatina refrains.

<u>Mathematics</u>

This term we will be:

- Subitising up to 3 objects.
- Linking numeral to quantity to 3.
- Exploring 2D and 3D shapes to create patterns as construction resources.
- Selecting shapes appropriately for activities.
- Sequencing daily events.

Understanding the World

This term we will be:

- Participating in hands on exploration using senses.
- Talking about differences between materials and the changes they notice.
- Talking about what they see in their own environment.
- Exploring the changing season.
- Investigating clothing for seasons.
- Learning about the self and what they can do now.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be:

- Exploring Colour recognising colours / choosing colours for a purpose.
- Using thick paint brushes and glue sticks independently
- Manipulating playdough in different ways (rolls, cuts, squashes, pinches, twists).
- Developing storylines.
- Participating in small world play.
