Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter - Term 2A.

English:

<u>Reading:</u> We will be having 4 reading sessions each week where we will focus on reading the text and answering questions based on the following content domains: vocabulary, retrieval, summarise, inference, prediction, sequencing, word meaning and comparison.

Writing: In English this term, we will be studying the text, 'Bog Baby'. From this vehicle text we will be following the cycle of immerse - analyse - plan - write and edit. We will be writing a narrative for our fiction writing and a set of instructions as our non-fiction focus.

Spelling: As part of our spelling lesson this term, we will be focussing on the following rules: The 'j' sound spelled 'g', 'ge' and 'dge'; the 'o' sound spelled 'a' after 'w' and 'qw'; and adding the 'ed' suffice.

Mathematics:

In Maths this term we will be focussing on the following topics: number (multiplication and division), measurement (money) and statistics,

Science:

Our Science topic this half term is Plants. As part of this topic, children will be taught to:

- observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy

Religious Educations

Our Religious Education topic this half term is Jesus: The aims of this topic is to increase the children's awareness that Jesus was an extraordinary person who welcomed everyone as a friend, and to develop knowledge and understanding that Jesus had the power to miraculously heal people. The key questions we will be answering through this topic are: What is a miracle? Why are these stories important? Why did Jesus welcome everyone? I wonder how it felt to meet Jesus? What did Jesus want us to learn from his behaviour? What do these stories reveal about Jesus?

<u>History</u>:

Our History topic this half term is The Stone Age. We will be learning about pre-history, the hunters of Doggerland, Skara Brae and Stone Henge.
